

# OPTIMIST YOUTH FOOTBALL

## -Policy on Video Taping-

The OYF Program recognizes that parents and relatives want to video tape their children playing football. We encourage this practice and support it as long as the parents adhere to these guidelines:

1. Stay on the parent's side of the field.
2. Do not film from either end zone.
3. Do not use any device such as ladders, scaffolding, etc., to film from.
4. Only film their child's game.

The OYF program does not allow anyone including coaches, parents, relatives, etc. to film an upcoming opponent's game, **no matter what the reason**. By OYF rules, the head coach is responsible for the actions of his players and their parents. It is the coach's responsibility to make sure that they understand this rule, and it is recommended that the coach present this rule, and any additional information that the parents should be aware of in a team parent meeting prior to each season.

If a verifiable violation of this videotaping rule occurs, any actions taken will be determined by the OYF Executive Committee, Coaches Review Committee, and/or the League Directors.
